Oxford Baptist Church – January 8 – Robin W. Pifer Communion – "Understanding the Lord's Supper *Matt 26:26-30; Luke 14:15-24; 1Cor 11:23-29; Exod 12:1-11*

Big Idea: Jesus offered himself so that we have life and forgiveness. We remember and celebrate this reality when we take Communion—what some churches call the Lord's Supper or the Eucharist. Believers drink wine or juice and eat bread together. In this meal, we refocus on our relationship with Jesus and one another.

Introduction

- a) In Communion, we remember Jesus' sacrifice on the cross for us *1 Cor 11:23-25*
- b) In Communion, we slow down to examine ourselves 1 Cor 11:28
 - We confess our sins, we ask God to forgive us, and we reconcile with one another
- c) In Communion, we declare that Jesus is coming back 1 Cor 11:26
- d) In Communion, we bring our sins, fear and weakness to Jesus *Ps 34*:8
